I personally have seen bricks thrown at and bounce off of windows that have been treated with 3M™ Scotchshield™ Safetv & Security Window Film. No other window film manufacturer has more experience with window film than 3M.

Caveat emptor! There are window film dealers who sport the 3M logo yet are not authorized to sell or install 3M window films. If you ask for 3M and are diverted to a film – produced by anoth-
